There were 269 District-Wide students recognized as AP Scholars, with an average score of 3.98.

All District-Wide High Schools are recognized across the state as leaders in Advanced Placement. Students in Monongalia County annually outperform both the state and national averages with 70% of students receiving passing scores. Approximately 58% of students receive a passing score nationally.

PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

PROMISE Scholarship Requirements

- Student must live in West Virginia for 12 consecutive months prior to applying for scholarship.
- Student must complete high school graduation requirements at a West Virginia public or private high school.
- Student must achieve a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or whatever is considered a "B" average.
- Student must meet ACT or SAT score criteria.
